Built in 1941 into 2,125 sq.m. of hillside opposite the castle, this fortress forms part of the National Redoubt developed by the Swiss government from the 1880s, though this site had been fortified since at least the 12<sup>th</sup> century. A labyrinth of over 20 immersive rooms on several levels (even if you're claustrophobic, this shouldn't be an issue as the spaces are large), it can now be visited like a theme park. Classified top secret till 2001, it opened to the public in 2020.

Price: seniors CHF 20; children 6-17, AI & reduced mobility CHF17; family of 2 adults & 2 children over 6 CHF 70). Reduced price for a group of 10+. Parking in front, and near the castle. We'll have lunch in the Konkordiaplatz where the soldiers used to sit...
